Year 6 SATs Information

Year 6 Parents - SATs Information - Week beginning 13th May.

On Monday 13th May, our year 6 children will begin their national assessments in Reading, Maths, Spelling, punctuation and grammar (SPaG) which are both set and marked externally. The results of the assessments are used to measure your child's learning journey throughout their time at Eynsham, and class teachers will use these tests, alongside teacher assessments, to give a picture of their attainment.

The timetable of the week will be as follows:

Monday 13th May - English grammar, punctuation and spelling Paper 1: questions and Paper 2: spelling

Tuesday 14th May - English Reading

Wednesday 15th May - Mathematics Paper 1: arithmetic and Paper 2: reasoning

Thursday 16th May - Mathematics Paper 3: reasoning

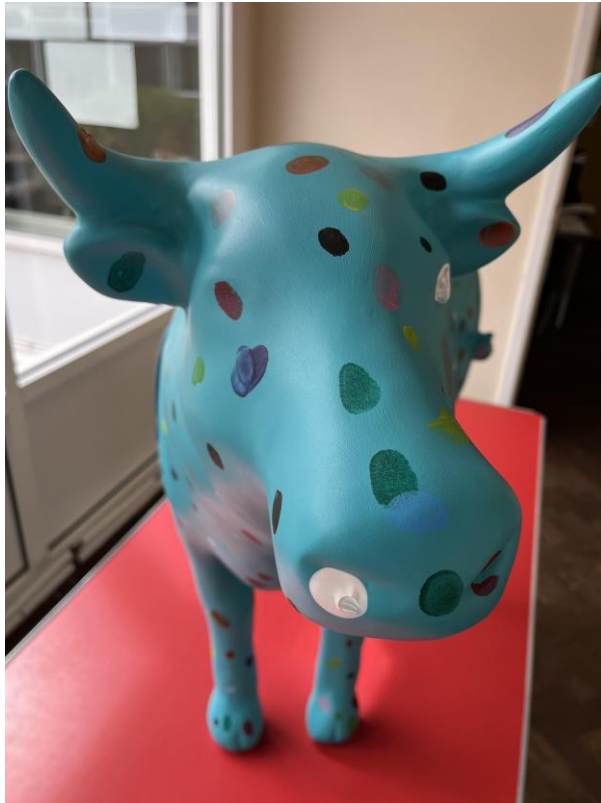
