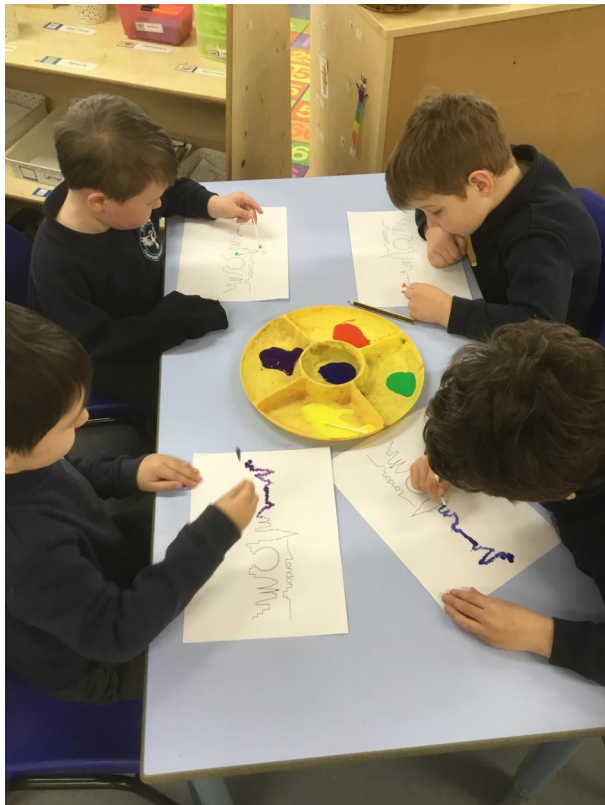
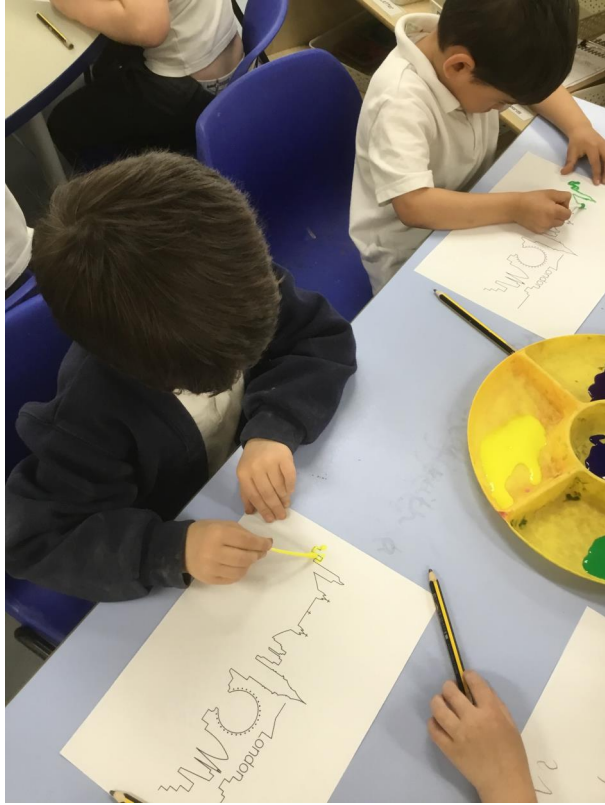
## Reception News
