Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope that you and your families have enjoyed the Christmas break and that you were able to meet up with family and friends. Firstly, a big thank you for all the cards and gifts that you gave to the staff at the end of last term. We really do appreciate all your support and kind wishes.

### What your child will be learning this term:



During both their choosing and learning time and adult-led activities, the children will be exploring people who help us in school and the local community. We will explore what each job entails and hopefully have a visit from the police and fire service. The children will consider the qualities and skills needed for each job and think about their own strengths and abilities and what they might want to do when they are older. The children will be using their increasing knowledge of phonics to read and write simple sentences based around this topic, as well as sharing high quality texts.

### Ways you can support your child's learning at home:

**Reading:** The children will continue to bring home books from our scheme which means they have been taught all the letters and words contained in each book. Please find time to share a book with your child at least 3 times a week. When your child reads at home, they can record this in their Reading Diary. When they record three reads within a week, they will receive a house point and the book will be changed. We will read with your child at least once a week and record this in their diary, so please ensure it is brought into school each day.

**Phonics:** Please continue to practice the phonics word mat with your child on a regular basis. So far we have covered the following letters s,a,t,p,i,n,m,d,g,o,c,k ck e u r h b f ff l ll ss and Tricky words; I the no go into Please check tapestry each Friday where we will post the letters and words being covered that week.



### **Uniform:**

Children should wear plain white or navy blue polo shirts, grey skirts, trousers, shorts or pinafore dresses, and navy blue sweatshirts or cardigans. Socks should be black, grey or white and tights should be navy blue or grey. Footwear should be smart black shoes or plain black trainers (no logos). Please make sure that all items are named. No make-up or jewellery should be worn except for simple stud earrings, and long hair should be tied back please.

### **PE kits:**

All children will need a NAMED sports kit, including pumps or trainers for PE this term. Your child will need a plain navy TShirt or school sports shirts, black shorts and black trainers. Please bring your PE kit and leave on their peg to be used in the week.

### **Water bottles and snacks:**

Children need a named water bottle in school each day. This needs to be taken home to be washed out and refilled. Foundation Stage are provided with a piece of free fruit or vegetable at snack time every day.
