Welcome to Year 1

Dear Parents and Carers,

What your child will be learning this term:

This term in Year 1, we will be learning about the famous Lost Railway of Eynsham! During our topic, we will be looking at different types of transport and importantly different types of trains through the ages. We will explore why the railway was so important for Eynsham and visit the model railway in the Bartholomew Room. For our children to thrive at Eynsham, we believe that History and Geography should be closely linked, therefore, we will also be looking at different maps of Eynsham during our topic and thinking about where the Railway was in relation to our homes and school. We will also be looking for Witney on the map and learning about the Blanket Trade in relation to transport.



Ways you can support your child's learning at home:

Reading – We encourage the children to read at home at least three times a week to supplement their phonics learning and encourage them to continue to practise segmenting and blending. We ask that you kindly make a quick note of when your child reads at home so we can keep a log of this, and we will do the same when we read with them in school. When you log their reading 3 times, they will receive a house point. The children will flourish in Year 1 with their reading, and they will make lots of progress. We encourage children to read the same book 3 times to become fluent and aid comprehension, so that they understand what they are reading. We will check reading record books every Monday and Thursday and change the children's reading books when we think they're ready to progress onto the next book and/or level. However, do let us know, by catching us at the door or writing a comment in their journal, if you think your child's book needs changing sooner. We want to be able to hear your children read as regularly as possible so, please ensure your child's reading book and diary are in school each day and the diary is kept up to date with reading responses.

Homework – For homework in year 1, the expectation is that children will access a Numbots account that has been made for them. We encourage them to do this as often as they like. The children will bring home their log ins for you to use on this account. As part of their homework, it is also essential that children read at least 3 times a week.
