

1	Set up a partnership with a another school in a European country (France).	To widen children's understanding of the continent that they live on and draw comparisons to where they live. This can include language, food, school life and historical buildings.
2	To create a link to a charity in Africa to develop children's knowledge of the wider world.	Children to have an understanding of how children live on another continent, including daily life and school.
3	To create a link with Mandarin speaking children where children can exchange letters and conversation.	To help encourage children in year 5 and 6 to develop their Mandarin speaking, listening and writing by communicating with children whose native language is Mandarin.
4	To host a school international day.	To introduce the whole school to the language of Mandarin (due to lots of new pupils from Hong Kong) to help develop their cultural understanding.
5	The introduction of Spanish as a language in KS1.	Children in year 1 and 2 to have termly lessons on Spain starting with learning about major cities in Spain before branching out to Spanish speaking countries.
6	For lower key stage two develop their understanding of the Spanish language further by participating in weekly lessons.	For children to have weekly lessons looking at the Spanish language, including writing, speaking and listening.
7	To embed Mandarin into the UKS2 curriculum and enable children to work towards the ..... award	To introduce and embed mandarin into the upper key stage 2 curriculum and work towards the ....award.
