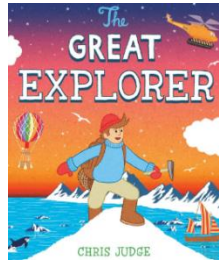
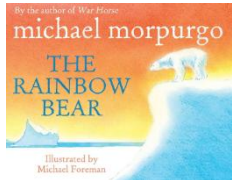


Frozen Planet

Terms 3 and 4

As geographers, we will be learning to use a compass and how to give directions. We will also be learning about the equator and how distance from the equator affects the climate. We will also be learning about Ernest Shackleton and how the regions he explored have changed over time.

As scientists, we will be developing our understanding of living things and their habitats as well as working on our scientific skills, such as observation and classification.

As designers, we will be making fairground wheels for our village which meets design criteria that celebrates Eynsham.

As artists, we will be exploring painting and mixed media. We will be developing our knowledge of colour mixing and exploring creating texture and patterns with paint.

In English we will be taking inspiration from the books, 'The Rainbow Bear' and 'The Great Explorer' as we write a narrative, a prequel, and a balanced argument. We will also write non-fiction texts such as an explanation text.

We continue to learn lots of new vocabulary and grammatical features. We will also learn how to use apostrophes for the first time.

In Maths lessons we will be focusing on the following areas:

- **Multiplication and division** (including the 2, 5 and 10 times tables)
- **Shape**
- **Geometry**
