Information for new families to school

- Regular school newsletters are sent out via 'Parentmail' and the first letter sent out in term 1 will include the main whole school dates for the year.
 - We use a communication programme called 'Parentmail' to send letters, newsletters and create payment items for trips. We will create you an account using the email you provided on the pupil admission form.
 - Each area of school will send out individual information letters 3 times per year, at the beginning of each old term.
 - Cloakroom doors are unlocked at 8.40 am every morning and registration is at 8.50 am. Afternoon school finishes at 3.10 pm.
 - School lunches are available at a cost of £2.45 Nursery (Ducklings) per day and £2.80 for years 3-6, they are provided by a company called Dolce. The pre-order and payment side of the system is through 'SchoolGrid'. An account will be set up for your child and you can install the app on your mobile device to pre-order meals on a weekly/termly basis. You can also pay/top up funds by card. Please note since September 2014 school meals are available free of charge for all Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children.
 - A mid-morning fruit snack and a drink of either milk or water is provided for all children in Foundation Stage. Children in Years 1 & 2 also get free fruit provided but need to bring in a bottle of water every day. Key Stage 2 (Years 3 – 6) children can bring in a fruit snack, as well as a bottle of water, every day for their mid-morning break.
 - Wraparound care is run by Earlyworld. They run a breakfast club from 7.30 am, an after-school club open until 6 pm, as well as holiday clubs. Information and charges for this are available by telephoning Earlyworld on 01865 881848.
 - We run an extensive range of children's clubs, with a new list going out at the start of each term. The information for these will also be available on the website
 - Uniform is as follows:
 - Navy sweatshirts, cardigans or dark navy gingham summer dresses
 - Grey trousers, skirts or pinafore dresses
 - Black, grey or white socks
 - Grey tights
 - White or navy polo shirtsFor PE children need navy shorts or jogging bottoms (for cold weather), navy logo PE shirt – plain navy t-shirt if you prefer. Navy logo hoodie – plain navy hoodie if you prefer. NO PE kit is required for Foundation Stage children. School book bags can be purchased from the school office/parentmail for £7.99 each.
